3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by D. FRANKFU04 no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished. Please note that the Transcript of Records may be somewhat delayed during holiday periods.

4. Termination of the agreement

This Agreement will be effective upon signature through both parties. It shall remain in effect for the time period indicated above. It may be subject to revision or modification by prior mutual agreement. This may include the alteration of schedules, mobility numbers, etc. Either party reserves the right to terminate this Agreement upon twelve months' written notice to the other party. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. In this case, the program(s) or the activity(ies) already approved by both parties shall be allowed to be completed under the conditions of this agreement. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."
