As most of the courses are carried out in Greek, it is desired that the students speak and write in Greek. However the Department accepts students whose English knowledge is assessed to the B2 European Level, because the Department offers the alternative possibility to the Erasmus students of getting the necessary credits by writing an essay-paper in English, or variety of courses which are taught exclusively in the English language during the academic year, if a minimum number of students is registered for the specific course.

Once completed, they receive an acceptance letter by e-mail within a max. of 6 weeks. Changes To Original Learning Agreement can only be made by students in the 2 weeks after the start of classes. Must respect this deadline.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. *[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]*
4. Termination of the agreement

This agreement will be in effect for the full duration of the ERASMUS+ Programme. In case of premature termination, a notice of at least one academic year will be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
