#### F. Information

#### 1. Grading systems of the institutions

I MILANO01: degree courses are structured in University Educational Credits (crediti formativi universitari – CFU). A university credit corresponds to 25 hours of work per student, time for personal study included. The average annual workload of a full time student is conventionally fixed at 60 credits. 1 CFU credit equals 1 ECTS credit. To obtain the credits the student must pass the final exam Min. 18/30=sufficient grade Max 30/30= excellent grade.

ECTS credits: 1 academic year= 60 credits / 1 semester=30 credits / 1 term-trimester=20 credits
