4. Termination of the agreement

This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by I September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Credits (1 credit = 25 hours total work)

1 full academic year = 60 credits 1 semester = 30 credits

A percentage grading distribution will be provided to each Transcript of Records, according to the single class degree and the average of the last three years.
